Cycling 4,450 miles across the U.S.A for Disability Awareness

George Mason University alumni and Northern Virginia native, Fernando A. Mico, cycles 4,450 miles across country, championing the disability community by raising awareness and funds.

In Autumn 2024, Fernando A. Mico was accepted to join the 2025 Journey of Hope Team. The team of 60, consists mostly of undergraduate students, from multiple universities, and brothers of Pi Kappa Phi fraternity. Fernando is 30 plus years the senior of the majority of the cyclists.

In the Summer of 2025, 2 teams of 30 men will spend roughly 2 and a half months, cycling across the United States of America, starting from either Seattle or San Francisco. They will finally meet together at the Capitol Lawn in Washington, D.C. Along the way, they will make several "Friendship Visits" to local groups and partner organizations, further drawing attention from media across the country.

Journey of Hope is one of many disability, outreach events produced by The Ability Experience. Pi Kappa Phi initiated the non-profit in 1977, and is the only Greek organization to have its own national philanthropy.

It is a worthy cause, spreading the message of inclusion to those of ALL Abilities. Fernando A. Mico hopes you'll join the team. He says, "We are grateful for any and all help, and support, in completing this Journey. Don't worry. The cycling part's on us." And as to the young men, more than half his age, "I will help any teammate struggling to keep up with me." His rallying cry, "Together. Game on. Dream ON!"
